- It will consist of two half days (19th of May afternoon and 20th of May morning) allowing sufficient time for networking.
- Networking sessions will be organised according to the Challenges and Objectives of the ICT Work Programme.
- The stands on the Challenges and Objectives will be manned by Commission officials and will serve as meeting points for interested people.
- There will be large areas for a more informal way of establishing partnerships.
